Festival of Strings, now in its 13th season, offers several programs designed for young musicians interested in developing their instrumental technique, improving their performance level, and furthering their love and appreciation of music.

Prima Volta Ensemble Tuition \$100

The Prima Volta Ensemble is a beginning level performing ensemble for string players ages 5 through 12. The program is designed to strengthen music reading ability and ensemble skills. The deadline for registration is June 6. Late application will be accepted on basis of space availability.

Debut Orchestra Tuition \$205

The Debut Orchestra Program for string players grades 5 through 10 is designed to strengthen musical and ensemble skills. Students will work with professional musicians in a variety of settings including music classes, sectionals, orchestra rehearsals and master classes. General music classes include presentations by guest artists. The orchestra will perform in the final concert. Audition is required. Debut Orchestra students wishing to participate in chamber music in addition to the orchestra should inquire about the Debut Orchestra + Chamber Music Program.

Debut Orchestra + Chamber Music Program Tuition \$305

Debut Orchestra students interested in participating in the Chamber Music Program may be accepted upon audition based on ability, maturity and space availability. Audition is required. The schedule is as listed above, along with the following additional time requirements:

Sunday, June 7, 1:30~3:00 p.m. – Opening Remarks, Ensemble Assignment, Coaching
Monday, June 8 thru Friday, June 12, 1:15~2:15 p.m. – Faculty Coaching
Friday, June 12, 3:30~5:40 p.m. – Faculty Master Class (optional, but highly recommended)

Audition requirements: scale and solo piece of the student's choice, sightreading

Festival Chamber Music Program Tuition \$205

The Festival Chamber Music Program is open to advancing string players and pianists (limited space available). Students rehearse and receive daily coaching from faculty members. Students will participate in master classes and attend presentations by faculty members and guest artists. Chamber music groups will perform in the final concert. String players will also participate in chamber music reading sessions during the week and perform in a large ensemble to conclude the final concert. Students must demonstrate appropriate reading and musical skills and demonstrate emotional maturity in order to be eligible for this program. Audition is required.

Monday, June 8 thru Friday, June 12, 1:15~5:40 p.m. – Rehearsal and Classes

Saturday, June 13, 10:45~11:15 a.m. – Large Ensemble Rehearsal

Saturday, June 13, 1:00 p.m. – Final Student Concert, followed by a reception

Audition requirements:

String players – scale and solo piece of the student's choice, sightreading

Pianists – 2 contrasting works (memorization not required), sightreading
